THE 58TH EMMY[®] AWARDS NOMINATIONS ANNOUNCED ***Maryland Public TV broadcasts ceremony on July 1***

Reston, VA June 6, 2016 – The National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences (NATAS) National Capital Chesapeake Bay Chapter (NCCB) announced the nominees for its 58th Emmy[®] Awards. There were 937 submissions in the 2015 Call for Entries in 105 separate categories of achievement. In all, 317 nominations were announced by chapter officials. The Emmys[®] will be presented at an awards gala slated for Saturday, June 25 at 5:00 pm at the Baltimore Marriott Waterfront Hotel.

The Emmy[®] Awards honors excellence in television production in various sectors of the television industry, including entertainment programming, news and documentary shows, sports programming and craft categories. The 58th Emmy[®] Awards will be broadcast on Maryland Public Television on Friday, July 1 at 8 pm on MPT2. The telecast is the first program to air on MPT's second television channel, MPT2, in its new high-definition format.

"I congratulate the more than 300 nominees," said Chapter President Les Heintz. "I also congratulate our Board of Governors Award recipient Jayne Miller, WBAL-TV investigative reporter, on the recognition of her career achievements," he added.
